Hinge Adjustment Guide

To secure Furniture to wall:

- 1. Position your furniture in the room, then place Wall bracket (A) on wall near pre-fixed Wall Bracket(C) pre-fixed to back of furniture, and mark position of (A) with a pencil.
- 2. Move furniture aside and secure Wall bracket (A) into wall using suitable wall fixings Screws or wall fixing not included. Seek professional advice if unsure of fixing.
- 3. Feed small end of Cable tie (B) down through fixed Wall bracket (A).
- 4. Repeat the same step to secure other Bracket (A), then reposition furniture in place.
- 5. Loop cable tie through pre-fixed Wall Bracket (C) and connect the cable tie. The cable tie should have both wall Bracket (A) and product connected.
- 6. Finish position of your furniture if required, then pull tight the Cable Tie (B).



Your furniture should now be protected from toppling over.
