Before beginning the assembly, check that you have the correct components. If for any reason you need assistance, please contact our customer service team on +44 (0) 1889 272 056.

Please read these instructions carefully before assembly and use.

- Make sure all plastic protection is removed before assembling.
- Attachment assembly should be carried out on an open, flat, level surface.
- · Please refer to assembly diagram as necessary.
- To avoid losing any small component or hardware, assemble your product on a hard level surface that does not have cracks or openings.
- To prevent any possible damage to the flooring structure, ensure this product is correctly lifted, whilst moving from one position to another.
- Follow all steps in order to properly assemble your product.
- · Wear correct safety gloves. Edges and corners can cause minor cuts if improperly handled during assembly.
- Do not force parts together as this can result in damage to the product.
- When applicable, tighten all components by hand first. Once all steps are completed, go back and fully tighten till firmly secure with the recommended hand-tool.




4. Planter Stacking Assembly






4. Planter Stacking Assembly (Continued)

Stage One




Locate and lower smaller planter into larger planter.

Stage Two



Locate clamp and secure both planters using M6 torx bolts (FK1).

Stage Three



Locate divider and ensuring the location tab locks into place, as shown above.

5. Care Advice

Designed and built to stand the test of time, your new planter is low maintenance; requiring little more than a periodic clean to keep it looking its very best.

Here's some advice on how to look after it:

- 1. Regularly wipe down metal surface with detergent-free, warm soapy water and a non-abrasive sponge to
- 2. Avoid using heavy detergents or power washers.
- 3. Perform maintenance checks at least once a year and ensure all fixings are secure.

6. Limited Warranty

Our Planter set comes with a 25 year warranty on all metal components, commencing from the date of purchase. The warranty includes manufacturing deficiencies and defective parts and extends to the replacement of these parts. Expenses for shipping, installation, replacement of worn parts and other cost are not covered by the warranty. The warranty lapses in case of mishandling and if any kind of unauthorised modifications are made to the appliance.
