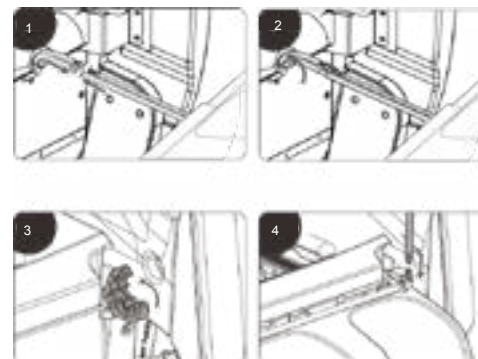

# 2. Installation parts

## Calf installation instructions

1. Insert the wire of the calf and the air pipe into the front socket of the steel frame assembly (Figure 1).
2. Then push the connected wire and air pipe into the hole in the backrest frame (Figure 2).
3. After the wire docking is completed, open the calf fixing covers on both sides of the steel frame assembly (Figure 3).
4. Lift the calf into the notch, close the fixing covers, and secure it in place with 2 pieces screws (Figure 4).

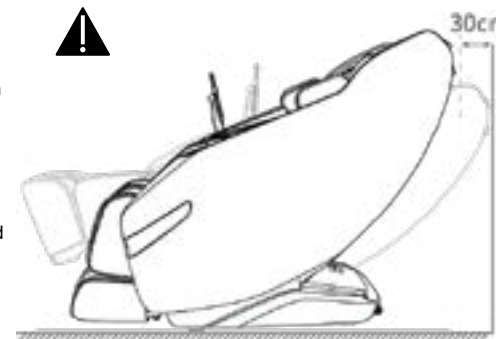


## Installation placement

**Make sure there is enough space for the massage chair can be tilted at least 30 cm.**



Do not expose the massage chair directly to high temperature environment due to sunlight (such as: in front of heating equipment, and place it to where can avoid high temperature and direct sunlight. It is recommended to lay a soft cushion for long-term use in a designated location. When laying the cushion, the size of the cushion should be enough to cover. Keep the range where the machine touches the floor and the range where your feet touch the floor.

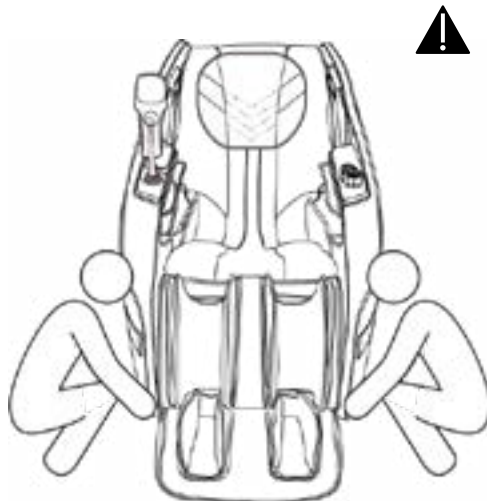

### Product lift instruction

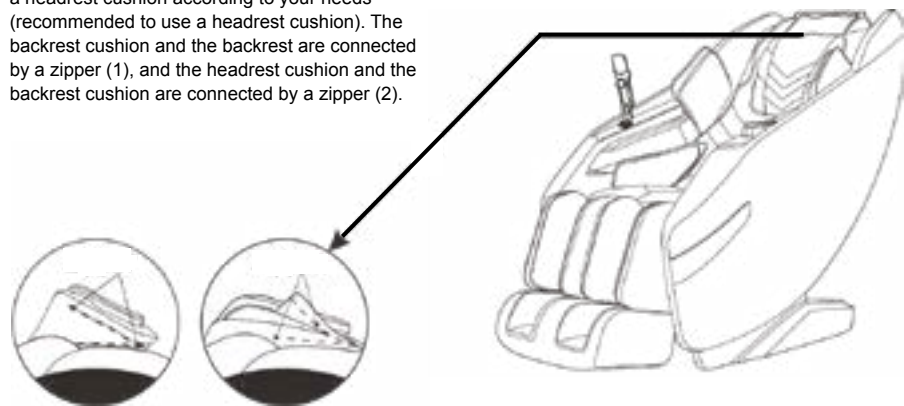
**Require team work to lift and move the chair to avoid injury.**

1. Please lift the massage chair to move it on vulnerable ground such as wooden floor.
2. When moving on a similar wooden floor, it is recommended to lift it. Avoid damage to the casters. When the floor is lifted and moved to the designated position, be careful to keep your hands out of the way to avoid injury, and be careful of your feet being crushed. Do not let go of the unit until the unit is completely flat, the floor may be damaged, therefore, it is recommended to place mats, etc. on the floor



### How to disassemble and use headrest cushion and backrest cushion

Using a headrest cushion can reduce the intensity of kneading massage on the neck and shoulders, and you can decide whether to use a headrest cushion according to your needs (recommended to use a headrest cushion). The backrest cushion and the backrest are connected by a zipper (1), and the headrest cushion and the backrest cushion are connected by a zipper (2).



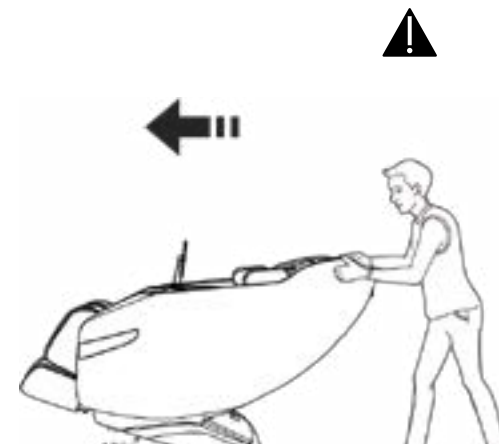

### Move method

**Use the rear casters to move the massage chair. Move the chair by tilting it down and backward about 45° as shown in the diagram.**

**NOTE: Excessive force to tilt will cause the chair to tip over completely and product damage.**

1. Before moving, please shut down the machine properly to reset the whole machine, and then cut off the power.
2. Please keep the chair vacant when moving. (People, pets or clutter will not be able to stay on the chair.)
3. When moving, do not cross a drop barrier higher than 2mm or a gap greater than 5mm.
4. When using casters to move this product, single continuous movement is not supported; if the distance exceeds 50 meters, please make this product move slowly and evenly.

Make sure that there are no people, pets and other objects around the unit.

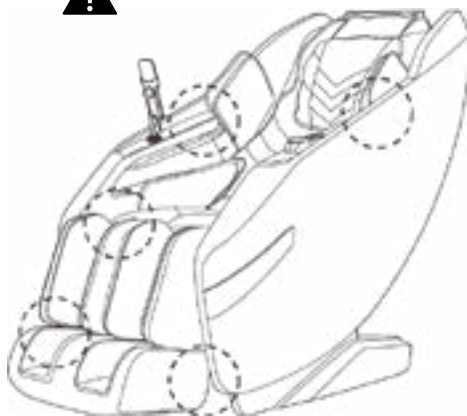


Make sure there are no foreign objects in the gaps of the machine

Under no circumstances should hands, feet or head be trapped under the fabric or leather covering of the massage area

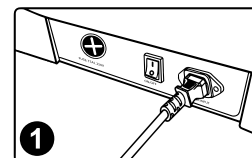

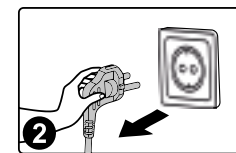

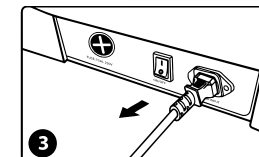

2. Schematic diagram of power on



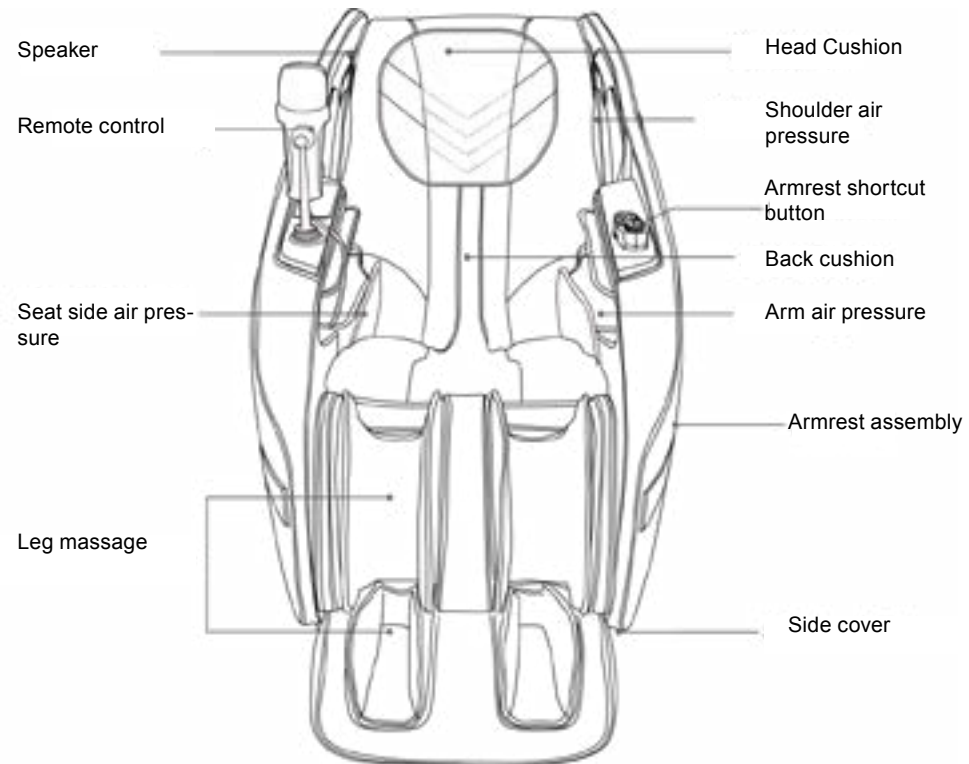

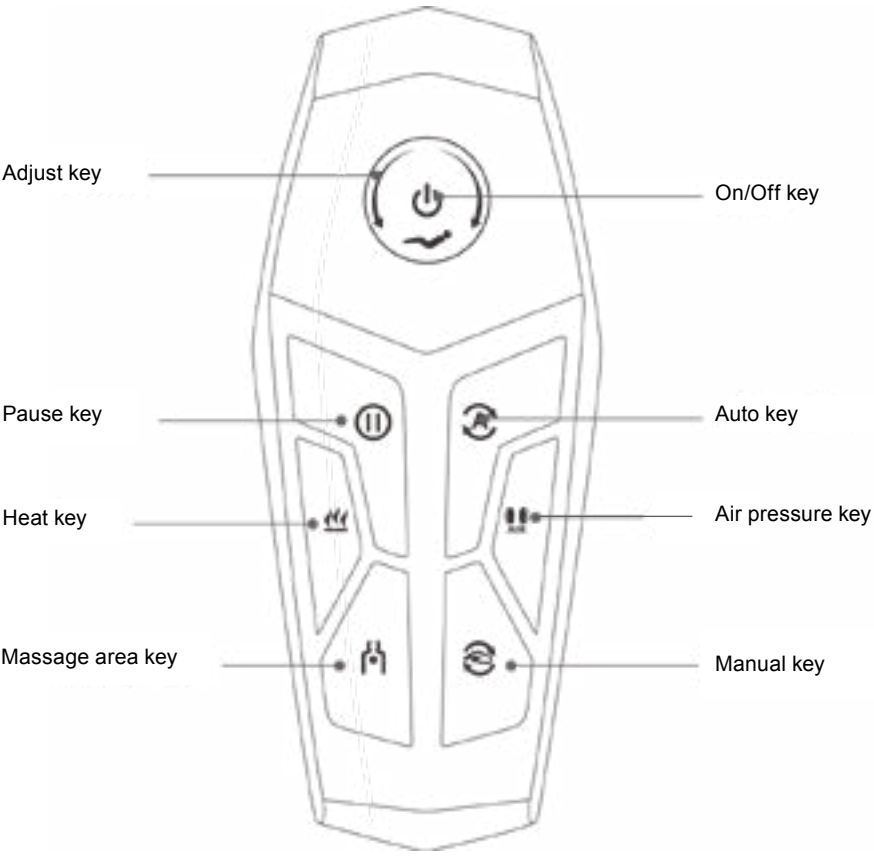


## 5. Remote Control










1. Display screen: The TFT display shows the massage function in use.
2. On/Off button: Turn on or off the massage chair.
3. Seat-Up button: The backrest and calf frames are adjusted at the same time to get the most comfortable massage posture.
4. Zero-gravity button: The massage chair has four zero-gravity angles. Press the button once to select the first gear, twice to select the second, three times to select the third, and four times to return to the initial state.
5. Up button: Use the Up button to move up in the menu or adjust the massage position.
6. OK button: Confirm the selected massage function or to perform confirmed massage.
7. Left button: Navigate the left button, return to the previous menu or select the option to the left.
8. Down button: Navigate the Down key, select the option downward in the menu, or adjust the massage position downward.
9. Other functions shortcut button: Access to other functions feature selection interface, for detailed function see description in this manual.
10. Automatic button: Access the user interface for selecting the automatic function mode. For more information, see 'Automatic programme'.
11. Shortcut button for manual operation: To enter interface for selecting manual operation, for detailed function see description in this manual.
12. Bluetooth button: Turn on or off the Bluetooth function.
13. Pause button: Pause all currently running massage functions, and press this button again to continue running all massage functions before the pause.
14. Seat-Down button: The backrest frame and calf frame are adjusted simultaneously to achieve the optimal massage angle and seating position, ensuring a comfortable and effective massage.
15. Right button: Navigate the Right key to enter the sub-menu, or select the option to the right.
16. Setup Function Shortcut button: To enter the setup function selection interface, for detailed function see description in this manual.
17. Menu button: Enter the main menu selection interface. For detailed function see description in this manual.

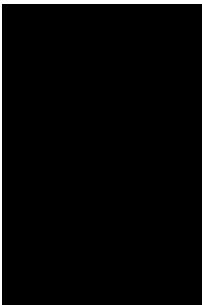
Function	Description
	Power key: Short press this key to turn ON/OFF the massage.
	Lying knob: By rotating this knob clockwise, the backrest will Linkage move downward slowly and the legrest will rise slowly; by releasing it, such DOWN/UP action of the backrest and the legrest will be stopped.
	Linkage sitting knob: By rotating this knob counterclockwise, the backrest will rise slowly and the legrest will move downward slowly; by releasing it, such UP/DOWN action of the backrest and the legrest will be stopped.
	Press this key during massage, and all the massage actions will be suspended at once. (i.e. the massage chair will turn off after 20min). Then press this key again to restore all the previous massage actions.
	Auto mode key: each time the key is short pressed, it will be switched to next automatic massage function.
	Heat treatment key: Click the key to enable or disable the heat treatment function.
	Air pressure key: Each time the button is pressed, it switches to an air pressure mode, with a total of four modes (including turning off air pressure), which can be switched cyclically.
	Massage area key: press this button to switch the back area mode.
	Manual mode key: each time the key is short pressed, it will be switched to next technique massage function.

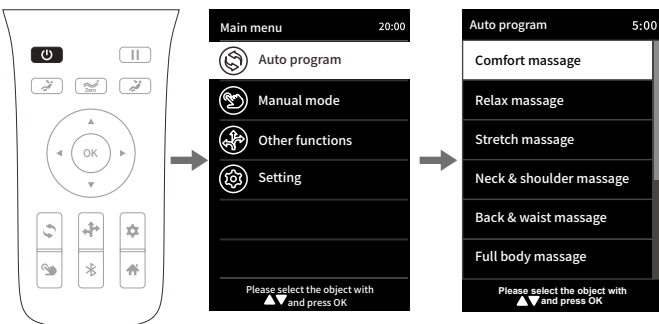
## 1. Standby



After switching off, the chair is in standby mode (LED off).

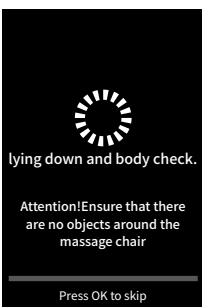
## 2.Start massage (on/off key)

Press the ON/OFF button to start the massage. Enter the start-up screen, select the auto program to start the massage. The chair will switch off automatically if no programme is selected within 5 minutes.



## 2.1. Angle adjustment and detection of the body shape

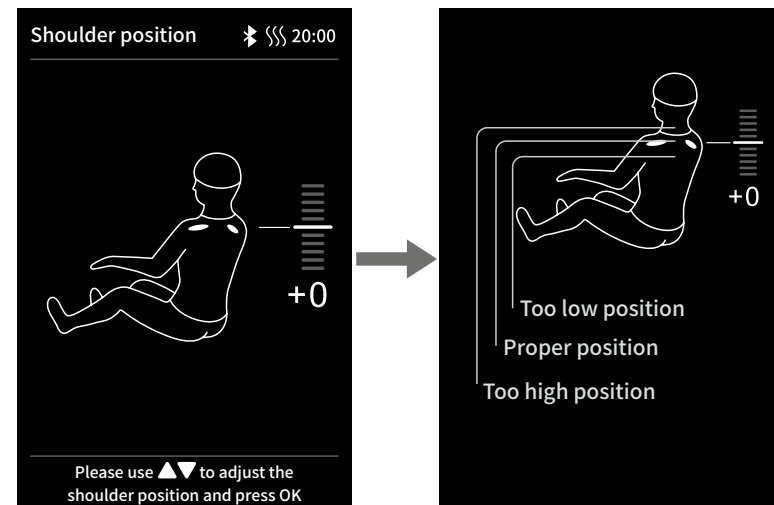
The angle will be adjusted accordingly, along with body shape detection (please note that you can press the OK key to skip this step).

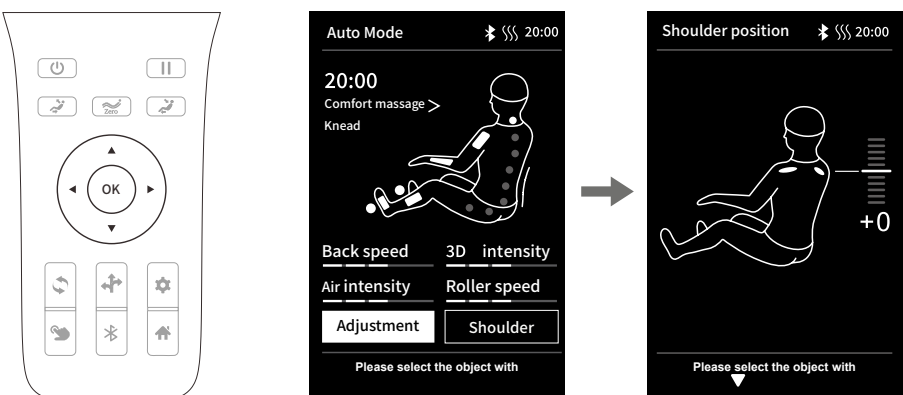
## 2.2Shoulder position adjustment

When the shoulder position is detected, the buzzer will beep. If there is a difference from the actual shoulder position, adjust to the appropriate position by pressing „Up“ or „Down“. The shoulder position can be adjusted in 11 steps. If the shoulder position has not been adjusted within 10 seconds, the system will automatically switch to the massage function. If you press the „OK“ button directly, you will enter the massage function immediately. Should the shoulder position not be detected, the massage will be performed at the default shoulder position height. Note: During massage, you can press „Right“ in the information interface to select the „Shoulder adjustment“ menu, press „OK“ to enter the shoulder adjustment interface, or adjust the shoulder position by pressing „Up“ or „Down“.





Key	Description

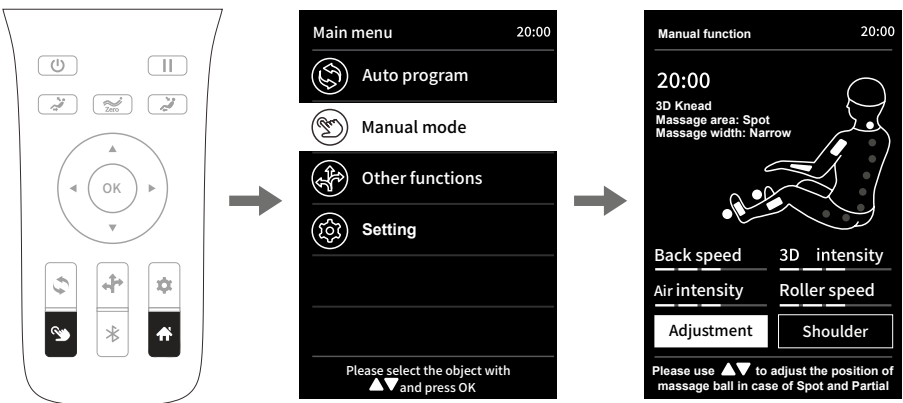


### 3. Massage head adjustment

If you need to adjust the position of the massage head after selecting a massage programme, press the ,Menu  , button on the remote control and select the manual function you want to adjust. You can also press the , Manual  , button on the remote control directly and select the manual function you wish to adjust. You can also press the ,Manual' button on the remote control directly and select the manual function you wish to adjust. Then press the ,Left' button to return to the information interface (,Manual function' becomes the user interface of the information interface).


You can press the ,Up' or ,Down' button directly from the manual functions interface to move the massage head up and down when the massage area is in ,Spots' or ,Partial'.

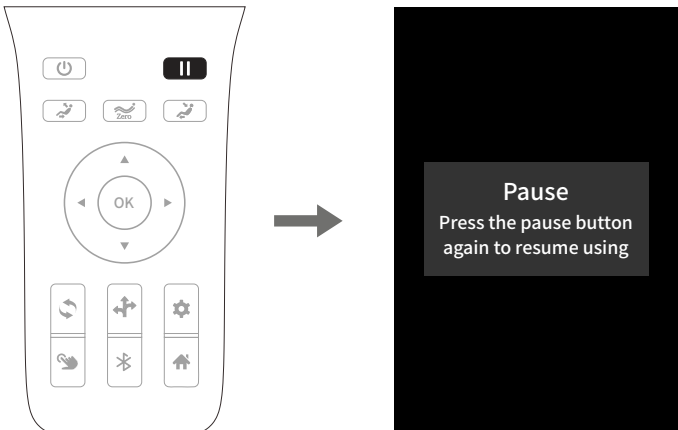
If the area to be massaged is not Spot or Partial, you must select Massage Adjustment from the manual function interface. Then select the massage area, select Spot or Partial, press the ,Left' button to return to the information interface and press the ,Up' or ,Down' button to move the massage hand up and down and adjust it.

### 4. Pause button

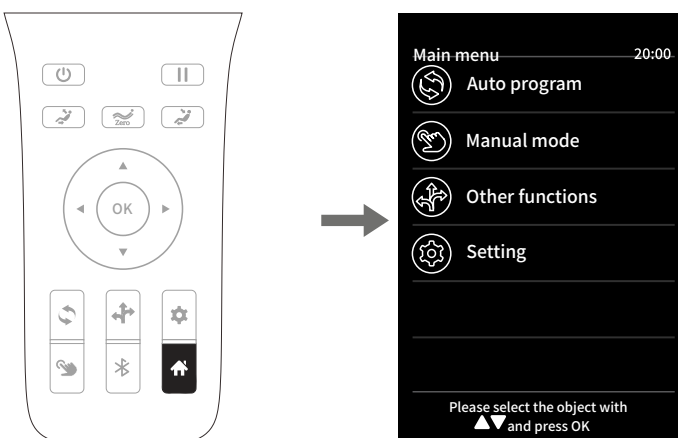
When the massage function is running, press the pause  button to temporarily stop all running massage functions; press the pause button again to resume the massage function before the pause. If the pause is longer than 20 minutes, the machine will automatically switch off.



### 5. Menu button

Press the ,Menu  , button to enter the main menu message function selection interface, including automatic function, manual function, other functions setting and other function interfaces.

Enter the menu interface, press ,Up' or ,Down' to select functions and press ,OK' to enter the next level of selection; press ,Left' to return to the previous menu interface.



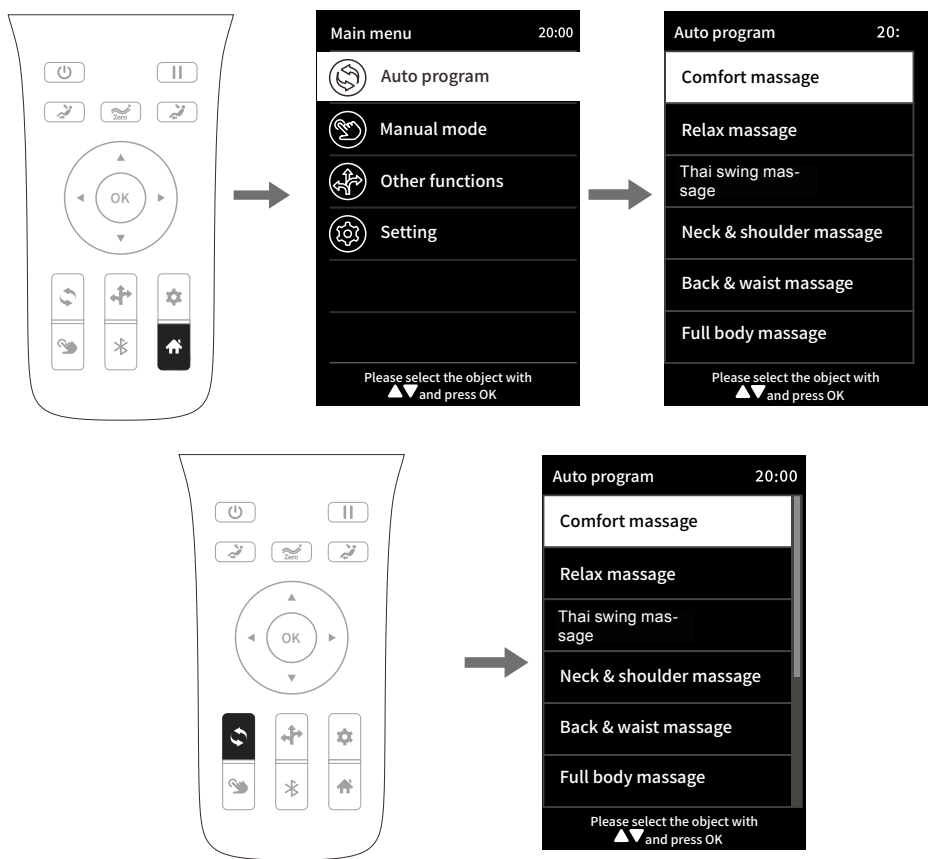

## 1 . Automatic function

Press the „Menu“ button, press the „Up“ or „Down“ button to select the automatic function, press the „OK“ button. You can directly press the „Automatic“ button on the remote control to enter the automatic function selection as well.

There are 15 automatic massage functions: Comfort massage, Relax massage, Strech massage, Neck and shoulder massage, Back and waist massage, Full body massage, Spine focus massage, Recover massage, Meridian massage, Pro massage, Night massage, Gentle massage, Refresh massage, Lower body massage and Body balance massage.

Enter the automatic functions interface, press the ‚Up‘ or ‚Down‘ button to select any automatic functions massage programme and return to the information interface. The information interface will be displayed as an information screen with automatic functions.

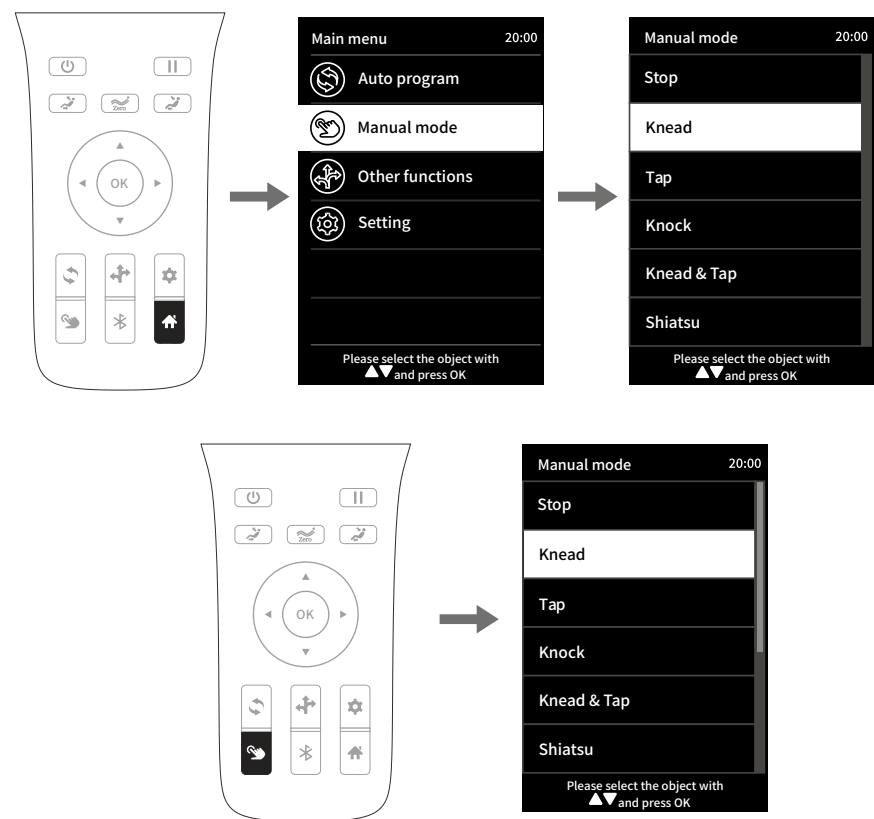

## 2. Manual function

Press the „Menu“  button to enter the main menu interface, press the „Up“ or „Down“ button to select the manual function, and press the „OK“ button. Alternatively, you can press the 'Manual'  button on the remote control to access the manual function interface.

There are 9 manual massage functions, including Knead, Tap, Knock, Knead & Tap, Shiatsu, 3D Knead, 3D Tap, 3D Knead & Tap and 3D Shiatsu.

After entering the manual function interface, use the 'Up' or 'Down' button to select the desired manual massage technique and press 'OK' to confirm. Once the technique has been selected, you will not automatically return to the information interface. Press the 'Left' button to return to the previous interface. When you return to the information interface, you will find that you have entered the manual massage information interface.

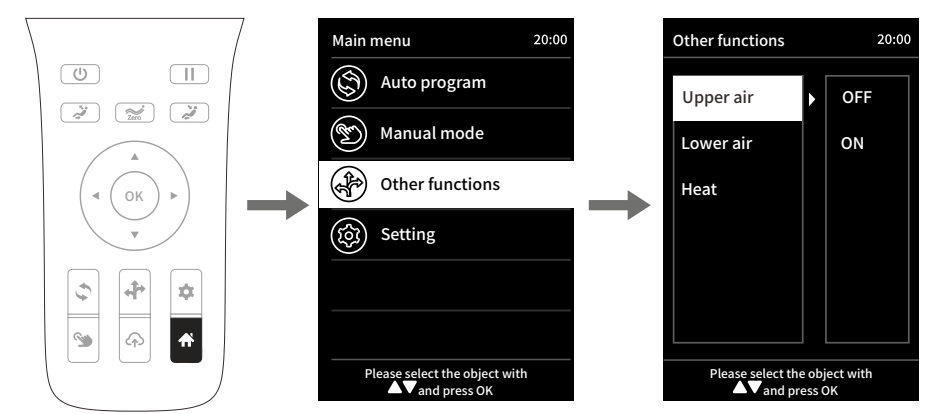

## 3. Other functions

Press the “Menu” button to enter the menu interface, press the „Up” or „Down” button to select other functions icon, and press the „OK” key. You can also press the “Other Functions” button on the remote control to enter the Other Functions interface.

Other functions include: Upper Air, Lower Air, Heating and other massage functions.

Once in the „Other functions” screen, use the „Up” or „Down” button to select the massage function you want and use the „Right” button to toggle it on or off, then press the „OK” button to confirm. Press the „Left” button to return to the previous menu interface.

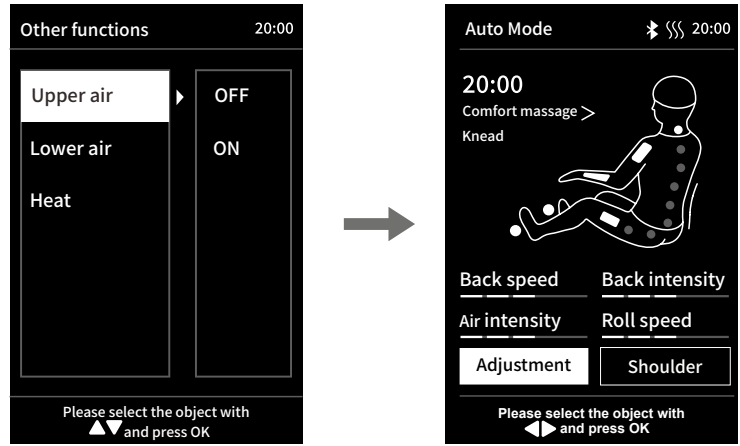

## 1. Other functions - Upper Air

Upper Air: includes shoulder air, arm air massage and hip air pressure functions.

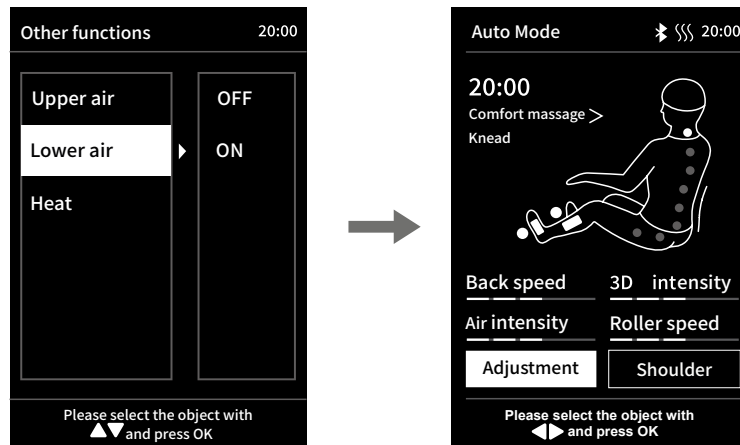
Enter the Other Functions interface, press the ‚Up’ or ‚Down’ button to select the Upper Air massage function, press the ‚Right’ button to turn the Upper Air on or off, then press the ‚OK’ button to confirm the selection. Press the ‚Left’ button to return to the previous menu interface.



## 2. Other functions - Lower Air

Lower Air: includes leg air and foot air massage functions.

Enter the Other Functions interface, use the „Up” or „Down” button to select the Lower Air massage function, use the „Right” button to switch Lower Air on or off and then press the „OK” button to confirm the selection. Press the „Left” button to return to the previous menu interface.

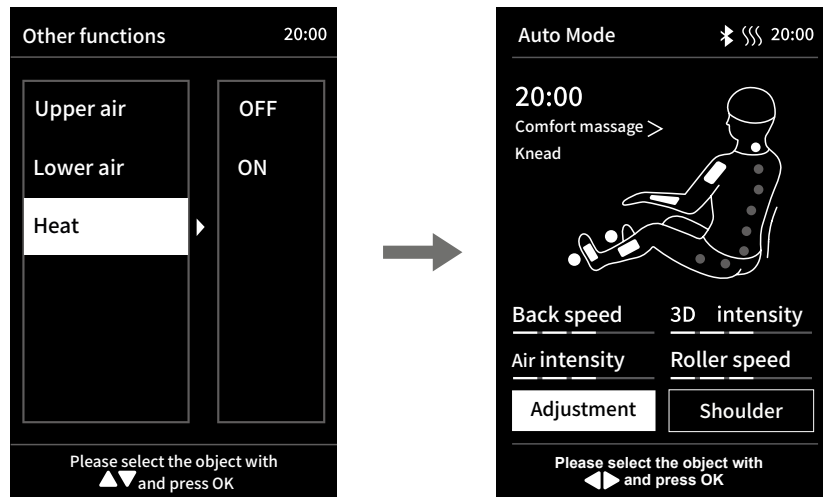

Heat: Switch the heat on/off. It takes about 3 minutes to heat up.

Enter Other Functions interface, use „Up“/„Down“ key to select Heating function, use „Right“ key to select On/Off, then press „OK“ key to confirm selection. Press the „Left“ button to return to the previous menu interface.



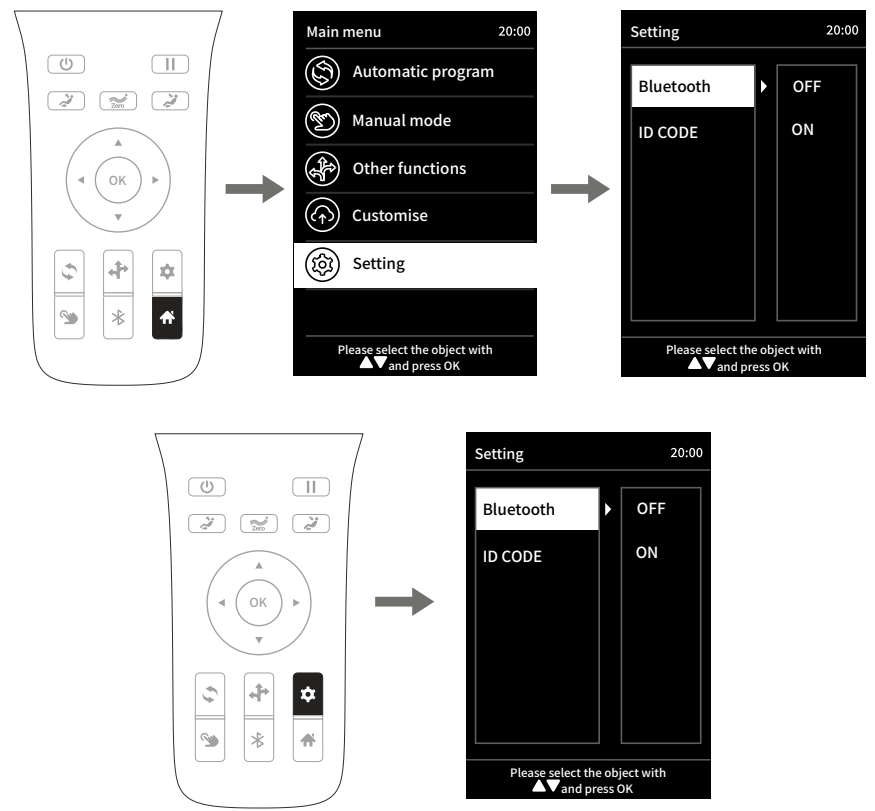

## 4. Setting

Press the „Menu“ button to enter the main menu interface, press the „Up“ or „Down“ button (or directly press the „Setting“ button in the information interface) to select the setting icon, and press the „OK“ button to enter the setting interface.

Settings include: language setting, Bluetooth setting, device ID and other settings.

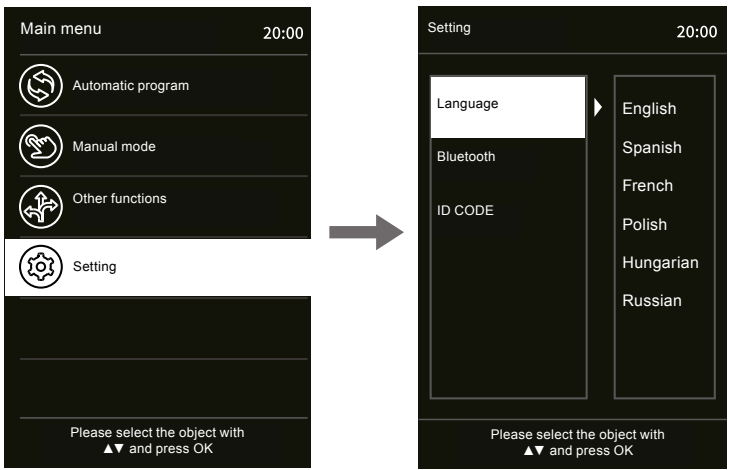

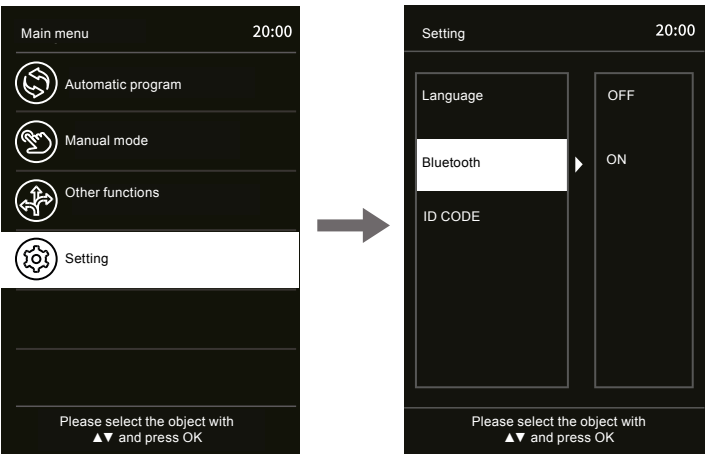
Go to the settings menu. Use the up and down buttons to choose your language and the right button to enter it. Then, select your language with the OK button and you're done. To go back, just press the left button.



## 2. Setting - Bluetooth setting

Turn on the Bluetooth function of the massage chair to connect the sound source device with Bluetooth function (such as mobile phone, MID tablet, etc.). After pairing and connecting with the Bluetooth module of the massage chair, the music played by the sound source device can be wirelessly transmitted to the sound system of the massage chair through Bluetooth for music playing.

Enter the setting interface, press the 'Up' or 'Down' key to select the Bluetooth setting, then press the 'Right' key to toggle the Bluetooth function on or off and press the 'OK' key to select. Press the 'Left' button to return to the previous menu interface.

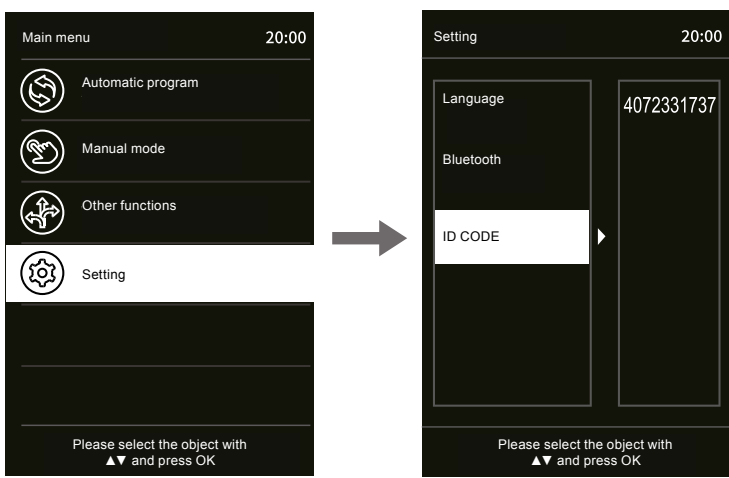

ID CODE: displays the current device ID number.

After entering the setting interface, press the „Up“ or „Down“ button to select the device ID and view the device number of the current device.





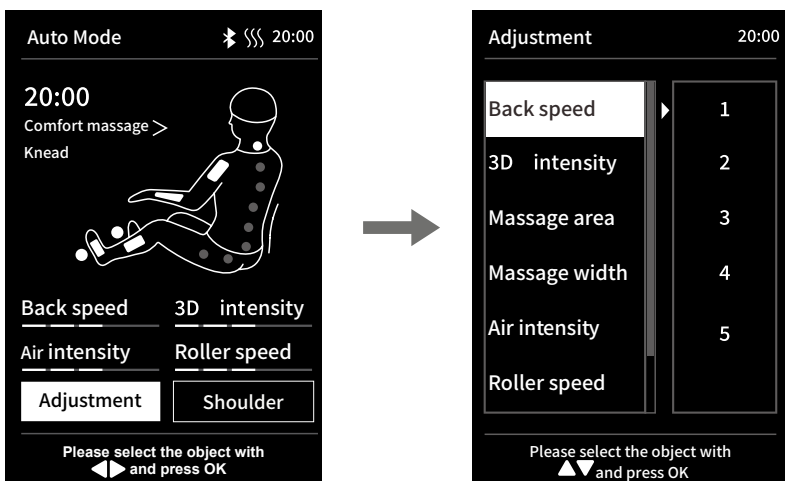

### 4. Massage adjustment

In the information interface, press the „Left“ or „Right“ button to select the massage adjustment button, and then press the „OK“ button to enter the massage adjustment interface.

There are 7 massage adjustment functions: back speed, 3D intensity, massage area, massage width, air intensity, roller speed, massage timing, etc.

Once you have entered the massage adjustment interface, press the „Up“ or „Down“ button to select the massage adjustment function you want to use. Press the „Right“ button to adjust the massage level and then the „OK“ button to confirm the selected level after selecting any massage setting. Press the „Left“ button to return to the previous menu interface.



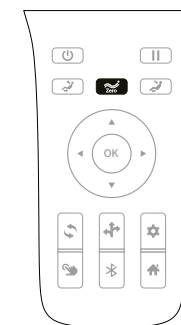
Function	Description
Back speed	Adjustable 5 levels in speed.
3D intensity	Adjustable 5 levels in intensity.

Please note that the available massage time may vary depending on the remaining duration. In the event that the displayed time does not allow for the addition or subtraction of a specific time interval, the relevant operation will not be available. For instance, if the manual controller displays 39 minutes, the available massage time adjustment range will be limited to -5 minutes or -10 minutes. It will not be possible to select +10 minutes or +5 minutes.



### Zero-gravity

Press the „Zero Gravity“ button to adjust the position of the zero gravity angle. According to your needs, you can select different positions of the Zero Gravity Angle. To enter the first level, press the button once. To enter the second level, press the button twice. To enter the third level, press the button three times. To return to the initial state, press the button four times.



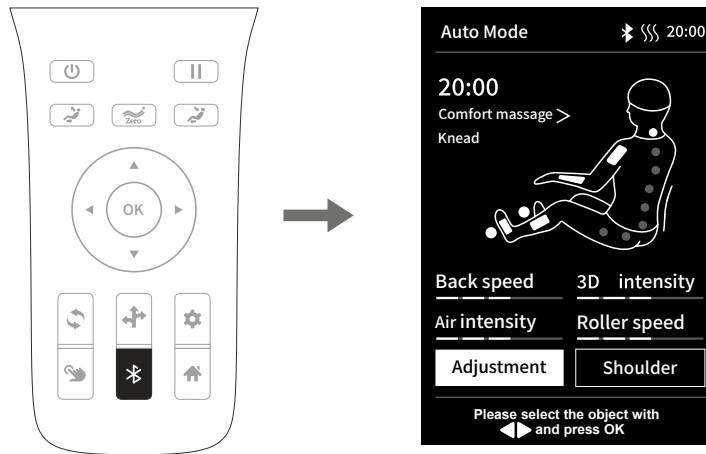
Button	Description
	The zero-gravity button allows the user to adjust the position of the calf frame and backrest frame to the zero-gravity position, as well as to select one of three zero-gravity modes and a seat-down off mode, which are cyclically alternated.

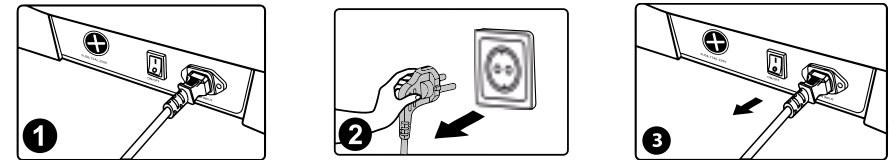


1. Bluetooth switch: To turn the Bluetooth connection on and off, press the "Bluetooth  " button on the remote control.
2. From the smart device's main menu, open „Settings“ and select „Bluetooth“. Open „Bluetooth“ and it will automatically „Search for a new Bluetooth device“.
3. The smart device will search for the corresponding Bluetooth model (IMCM- XXXX), click the „Pair“ button, when you are asked if you want to pair.
4. Turn on „Music Player“ in the smart device and select the song to play.

### End the massage

To power off the massage functions during the process, simply press the power button on the touch screen controller. This will also reset the backrest and leg rest. Alternatively, the massage timer will automatically power off all functions after the set time has elapsed, but the backrest and leg rest will remain operational. To power off the machine, switch off the main power switch.



# 7. Cleaning and Maintenance

Clean PU leather and plastic parts  
Wipe the leather with a soft, dry cloth.

- Do not use chemicals such as thinner, gasoline, alcohol, etc. to clean the unit.
  - When using commercially available leather care products, please follow the instructions for use.
  - If the PU leather is particularly dirty, wipe it by the following methods.
1. Immerse a soft cloth in water or hot water containing 3% to 5% neutral detergent, then wring it out thoroughly.
  2. Use the above soft cloth to wipe the leather surface.
  3. Wipe off the cleaning solution with a cloth soaked in clean water and thoroughly wrung out.
  4. Wipe with a wrung soft cloth.
  5. Let it air dry naturally.
- In the event that stains are proving difficult to remove, we would advise immersing a piece of commercially available melamine foam in a solution of neutral detergent and then wiping the chair with it.
  - Do not use a hair dryer to dry the surface.
  - As the color of the fabric will stain the surface of the PU leather, be careful when wiping the chair with denim and colored fabrics.
  - Please note that prolonged contact between these parts and plastic may result in discolouration.
  - Please note that PU leather may discolour when exposed to hair dye. To avoid any issues, we advise you to cover the affected area with a towel when dyeing your hair..



# 8. Troubleshooting

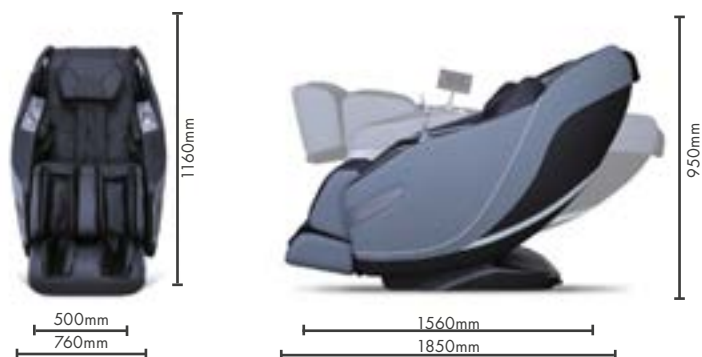
Malfunction	When the calf mechanism or the backrest reaches a certain position, the chair will no longer change the position when you press the desired setting button.
Solution	Due to the product design and ergonomic requirements, this product has safety limits for the position settings. An acoustic signal will sound when the limit is reached.
Malfunction	One or more functions do not work after the unit has been switched on.
Solution	After switching on the unit by pressing the power button, an automatic massage programme or another operating mode needs to be selected manually. If no selection is made, the unit will switch off automatically after 20 minutes. If manual operating mode is selected, the functions that are not selected can be deactivated and the operating mode will have to be set manually.
Malfunction	The unit makes a sound like rubbing leather when it changes position.
Solution	High-quality abrasion-resistant leather that meets environmental protection requirements is used for this product. Due to the special properties of leather materials, there is a slight noise caused by rubbing from movement in the corresponding area. This is normal. Please note: If you hear a noise that sounds like fabric or leather tearing when the machine is running, stop the operation immediately and contact a technician.
Malfunction	The massaging action does not reach the shoulders or neck.
Solution	If you have skipped the body scan before the massage (see 7.1 Operating the massage chair), you must set the shoulder position manually in the main menu. If this is not sufficient and the head does not touch the headrest or the back does not touch the loins, the shoulder position may be lower than the actual position during the body scan. Sit in the lowest position of the seat, lean your head on the headrest and start from the beginning.
Проблема	The unit is damaged. The power supply unit or the mains plug is unusually hot.

## 10. SPECIAL FUNCTIONS



### SPOT

The massage heads can massage a particular spot.



### KNEADING

Skin and muscles are either clasped and kneaded between the thumb and the index finger or with both hands. This massage technique is used in particular to ease tension.



### TAPPING

Short, tapping movements are performed with the edge of the hand, the palm or the fist. This promotes blood circulation in the skin and softens tense muscles. If tapping is performed at lung height, this can improve the release of mucus in the lung.



### SHIATSU

Shiatsu (finger press) is a form of body therapy originating in Japan. The massage technique consists of soft, rhythmic, far-reaching stretches and rotations. The aim of Shiatsu is to simulate individual parts of the body and to mobilise the muscles.



### AIR COMPRESSION

Rising and receding airbags have a pumping motion which produces natural muscle reflexes. This is particularly beneficial in the calf and foot area.



### KNEAD & TAP (DUAL ACTION)

The techniques of kneading and tapping are combined in order to relieve tension and stimulate blood circulation at the same time.



### AUTOMATIC

Specifically developed automatic programmes for the whole body, which offer a big range of different massage techniques. Additionally you can also turn on the heating function, if you'd like.



### BACK AREA

An individual applicable to any size massage area.



### CARBON HEATING

Deeply penetrating Carbon infrared heat, blood vessels expand, the blood flow increases and the muscle tone is reduced. In addition, it carries out a highly beneficial effect on nerve cells, which are responsible for reporting pain to the brain.
