


This product takes approximately **15 MINUTES** to assemble with **1 PEOPLE**.

All assembly should be performed on a flat, stable, clean and soft surface.



Step By Step Assembly Instructions

Step 1

- 1.1: Lay the chair on a flat, stable, clean and soft surface.
 - 1.2: Attach wooden dowels (D) & lock dowel steel (F) onto the pre-drilled holes on back frame (2) as shown.
 - 1.3: Attach back frame (2) onto seat frame (1) as shown. Ensure wooden dowels (D) & lock dowel steel (F) are aligned correctly with the holes of mating parts before attaching.
 - 1.4: Secure back frame (2) onto seat frame (1) using hex head bolts (A), lock washers (B) and flat washers (C) as shown. Ensure the pre-drilled holes on seat frame (1) are aligned correctly to the holes on back frame (2). Use allen key (E) to turn fittings (A) clockwise to fix.
- Repeat above procedure for the second chair.**

Care instruction for velvet fabric

Properties of velvet

Velvet fabrics are luxurious in nature, but as they have a raised surface texture they can be prone to shading and creasing with pile pressure. The unique aesthetic appearance of velvet is, in fact, in the natural shading which is created by the pile direction. Please note that pile crushing, indentations, marking & colour shading variation can naturally occur over time and with use.

Regular care

- In order to help maintain their appearance you can softly brush the pile in the opposite direction to the nap
- Vacuum lightly on a regular basis to remove any accumulated dirt that may accelerate wear and dull the colours
- Avoid exposure to direct and prolonged periods of sunlight, as colours might fade in the sun.
- Do not position upholstery close to sources of intense heat, such as radiators.
