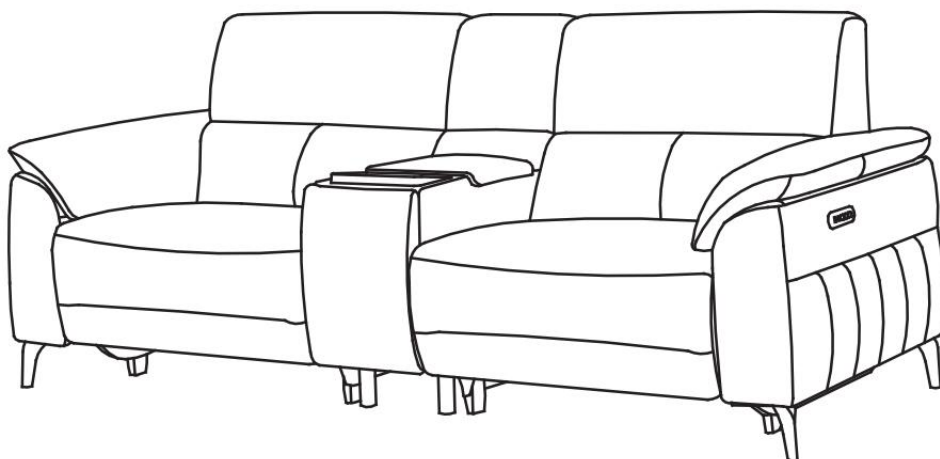

Caution

- Do not jump on the furniture.
- Do not sit on the arm and back
- Do not move the furniture by pushing or pulling it (Figs 1&2).

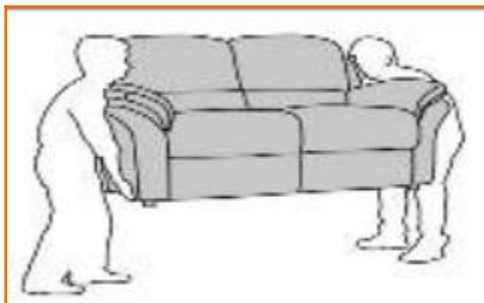
The correct way to move the sofa is by lifting it from the base with two persons using the correct lifting technique.(Fig 3).

- The sofa must be lifted and turned to return it to an upright position, but to avoid any damage, do not handle by the feet. (Fig 6)

- Avoid moving the sofa by dragging or lifting by the armrests, the correct way to move the sofa is by lifting it from the base. (Fig 6)

10 Do not allow children to play on the mechanized furniture or operate the mechanism leg rest folds down on closing so that a child could possibly be injured. Always leave in an upright and closed position. Keep hands and feet clear of mechanism. Only the occupant should operate it.

Quality upholstery will last for years if some basic advice is followed.

DO



Rotate reversible cushions regularly.



Vacuum your furniture regularly (using a soft brush attachment!)



Shampoo using an upholstery shampoo (test on an inconspicuous area first).

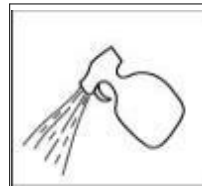


Always remove excess spills immediately from the surface of the furniture with a clean absorbent cloth using a light dabbing action.



Allow thorough drying before re-use.

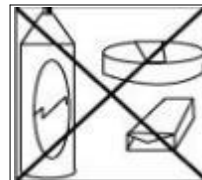
DO NOT



Do not wet fillings



Do not scrub with a stiff brush.



Do not use common household detergents

NOTE:

• Chenille fabrics are manufactured using high quality chenille(PIL E) yarns which may flatten during use. This effect can result in shading of fabric but is perfectly normal and does not affect their durability.

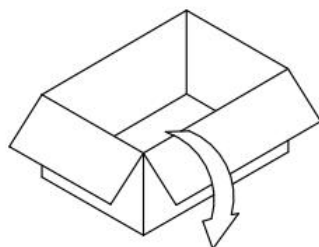
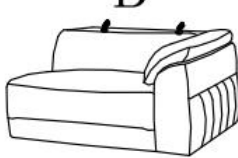
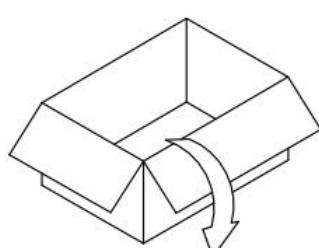
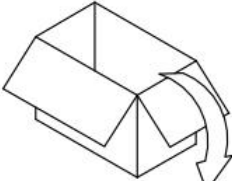
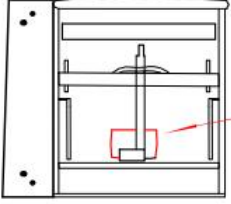

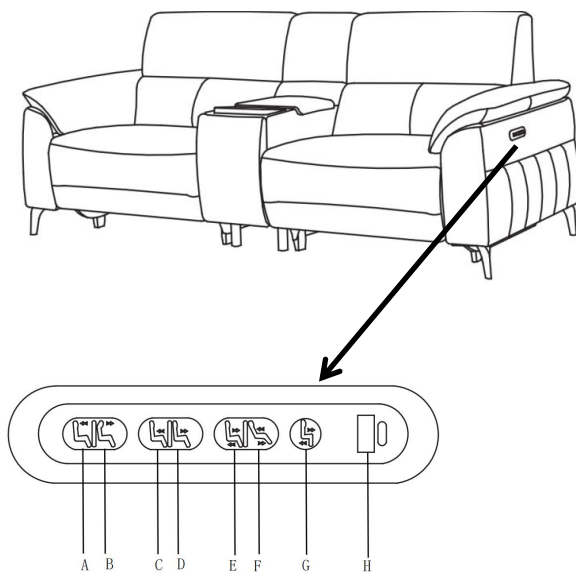
Operational Instruction

Power Mechanism

Deployment of the power mechanism is achieved by pushing the button on the outside of the sofa. Pushing the switch engages electric motors which extend or retract the mechanism depending on whether the extend or retract switch is operated.

Fitting the adaptor

1. Unpack the furniture and adaptor.
2. Connect the adaptor to the cable coming from the chair
3. Connect the adaptor to the power cable and plug the power cable into the wall socket.



Operation

The mechanism will recline the backrest and raise the footrest, using the switch button shown in Fig 8

1. Press the part(E) one button to recline the backrest & raise the footrest, the other button to return to a normal seat position (backrest up and footrest down.)
2. Press the part(A) one button to get the headrest to tilt and, the other button to return it to a normal position.
3. Press the part(C) one button to get the lumbar support and, the other button to return to a normal position.
4. Press the part(G) Home button to get all functioning parts return to their normal positions.
5. Connect the part (H) the USB ports to charge up cellphone, ipad, etc.



Caution

- Beware of entrapment. Keep hands and fingers clear of the tilt mechanism when operating.
- Ensure that children and pets are not playing or lying in the way when the mechanism is operated.
- Ensure that all cables are kept clear of the mechanism under the furniture.

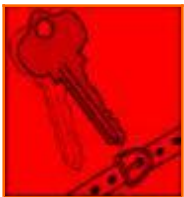
Additional advice on conditions to avoid



Your upholstery should not be exposed for long periods to direct sunlight.



Avoid leaving your upholstery too close to sources of heat (i.e.. Radiator or heater)



**Avoid sharp objects(buckles, jewellery, keys, pet claws etc).
Do not allow domestic pets to claw or climb on
the Furniture. Do not allow children to jump on the furniture**



**Avoid common cleaning materials, paints, solvents, nail
varnish, dyes, felt pens, dyed cloths(unless colourfast),
