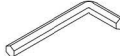
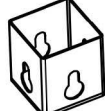
- **IMPORTANT** - The first step please take the time to read through these instructions before your commence assembly.

Safety advice

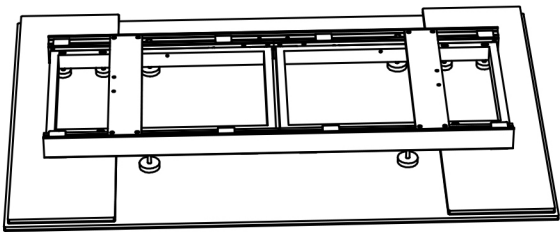
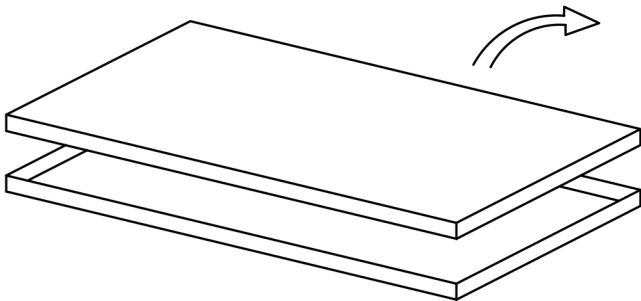
- Please keep these instructions for future reference.

- We recommend that you use a sheet or blanket to protect the floor and the product during assembly.
- Never push or pull the product as this could cause personal injury or damage to your product or floor.
- We recommend that you do not use power tools as this could cause damage to your product.
- From time to time check that there are no loose fittings (eg bolts etc), re-tighten when necessary.
- This item is not for outdoor use unless stated otherwise.
- No liability will be accepted for damage of injury caused by incorrectly installed or assembled furniture.

Ceramic care advice

Regular care advice “do”

One of the greatest advantages of a ceramic tabletop is how effortless it is to maintain. When it comes to cleaning, less truly is best. That means more time enjoying meals with family and friends—and far less time worrying about the clean-up afterward. If the surface looks a little messy, simply wipe it down with a damp cloth or sponge and a mild, diluted detergent (please ensure it is properly diluted).
Yes, it really is that simple.

Regular care advice “don’t”

“You mean I don’t need to scrub it down or polish it every day?”
That’s correct. Ceramic is exceptionally durable and is scratch-resistant, but not scratch-proof. Use felt pads under decorative items and tableware. This means you can enjoy the beautiful appearance of your ceramic table without the constant maintenance that other materials often require.

Other care advice

We know the tables are heavy but try not to drag them as you risk damaging your floor.
Ensure you are helped by when moving the table.
Occasionally, maybe once every 1 or 2 year’s (depending on use) the bolts on the table could do with a quick tighten.
