





Construction Details

Frame

As standard our buildings are a timber frame construction. This is built to a very high standard using c24 timber and external grade ply & OSB. Our rooms are based on a quality design and build. Due to our attention to detail, our rooms will outlast all of our competitors.

Where we differ is we increase the size of the stud (and reduce the centers of the stud) based on room size. All of the timber used in our designs is based on UK span tables, ensuring that we work to the very highest standards.

Our timber frames are the strongest on the market because we bridge multiple studs. This also helps to combat cold bridging which effects the warmth of your room.

Another thing we do differently is our frame build-up. We have a very effective technique to ensure that your building has sufficient air-flow around the frame. Wind will drive rain through the smallest of gaps and, with insufficient air-flow, water would simply sit behind your cladding. Two things would happen - your cladding will eventually discolour (and eventually rot) and the heat from the building will pull the moisture in resulting in damp spots. Our design prevents this happening.

Each wall panel is made as follows:

- Cladding
- Battens
- Breathable membrane
- Outer skin
- Timber stud
- 100mm PIR insulation
- Plasterboard
- Skim

Construction Details

Flooring

Our flooring is built to the same high standards as our walls.

Depending on the size of the room, and what it will be used for, will determine both the size of the timber joists and their centers.

Each standard floor panel is made as follows:

- 8mm Laminate floor
- Underlay
- Ply sheets
- c24 timber joist
- 100mm PIR insulation board

It's important to allow a minimum gap of 50mm underneath the base of the garden room for sufficient air-flow.

Our footings will always sit above the ground (to allow for air-flow).

*If you would like the building to be level with existing patio or decking, the ground beneath your room will need to be excavated to accommodate the timber frame and to allow air-flow.

Construction Details

Roof

The roof of our buildings is again based on UK span tables, which allow for wind uplift, rain, snow and a deadweight loading.

As standard, our rooms are built to appear square from ground level, however, all of our flat roofs have a minimum 4 degree fall on them from front to back. We frame the front and sides to give a more modern appearance.

The front of the roof is finished with an aluminium fascia, whilst the sides & back has a PVC fascia, gutter and downpipe.

Our roof is designed in accordance with UK span tables and is described as a "cold roof" build up, with ventilation in the front & rear soffit, and with sufficient space above the insulation to allow the roof to self-regulate.

Each roof panel is made as follows:

- EPDM rubber & adhesive
- Ply sheets
- c24 timber joist
- 100mm PIR insulation board
- Plasterboard
- Skim

Exterior



Cladding

We have a very strong relationship with one of the UK's largest and very best suppliers of cedar.


Our CDR range is based on Western Red cedar, a Canadian cedar tree that holds many benefits over the European and British equivalent.

Canadian cedar has a beautiful surface, is slower growing (& more dense) and smells amazing.

It's a mixture of reddish brown, that, left untreated, will silver over time. Treating cedar is easy - apply Osmo oil every 12-18 months to retain the colour and protect the timber.

Canadian cedar also has less visible knots than British cedar.

Interior

Electrics & Heating

We use a team of electricians who are well known to the business, have the necessary qualifications & experience and who's work we trust. Although not employed directly by us, they form part of our team and will provide the necessary certificates for each installation.

As standard, we include 3x white double sockets, each with 2x USB ports, white switches and 1 white spur for the heater.

The size of each room will determine the amount of downlights we install and their position is spaced out equally. Based on your design choice, any canopy lights will match those internally.

An electric, wall-mounted heater will be installed as part of your package. The size (wattage) of this is based on your room size and again based on UK based standards (BTU - British Thermal Unit).

A consumer unit will be installed in your room, which will allow you to turn on/off sockets and switches.

At the end of the build, we will provide you with an electrical certificate for the work carried out.

If you do not have power to the location of your build, we can take care of this for you. Although not part of our standard cost, we can provide a quotation for a full electrical installation - connecting your home fuse board to ours by way of armoured cabling. This quote is based on the distance from your fuse board to the garden room, the size of the cable required and any obstacles. Please feel free to ask for a quote.

We are happy to accommodate any special requirements, including extra lights, sockets or broadband and these can be quoted for separately. Again, please feel free to ask.







We offer a 10 year, insurance-backed guarantee with all of our garden rooms (upon completion of works and final balance paid). This is underwritten by HomePro (Jan2023) and guarantees that any design and manufacturing faults to the structure of the building will be taken care of by our team.

Depending on the manufacturer of your doors and windows, you could also benefit from a guarantee of **up to 20 years**! Again, this goes live upon completion of works and final balance being paid.

Windows & Doors



Doors

As standard our CDR range comes with 2m wide PVC French or Sliding doors and windows in Anthracite grey, however, they can come in a variety of colours, sizes and variations. We offer the opportunity to upgrade these to aluminium.

Also if you prefer bi-folding doors, these are available, however, we always supply these in aluminium only.

Our standard double glazed units for these French and sliding doors are toughened safety glass, Low-E, soft coat Planitherm ONE coating, 90% argon gas filled sealed units, with a warm edge spacer-bar and a centre pane U-value of 1.1 W/M²K. You can also have triple glazed sealed units, but weight and size restrictions will apply.

- Sliding doors 2, 3 and 4 panel configurations available.
- Excellent WER values.
- Multi-point locking system, consists of four sturdy bi-directional hook locks and a stainless steel one piece keep.
- Double or triple track option. 3 panels on a triple track, gives around a two-thirds clear opening.

Our sliding doors are fitted with high security multipoint locking as standard. The locking mechanism consists of a total of four bi-directional hook locks, which fully secure the sliding panels and help to prevent them from being lifted out of their track. The locking mechanism is operated by lifting the small lever on the handle, when the door is closed.

When closed the doors are secured by using a key to lock the cylinder, which in turn locks off the handle and prevents it from being used to operate the locks. These cylinders are highly pick resistant and drill resistant



Windows & Doors

Windows

Our designs are based on a modern looking garden room and so, unless specified, the windows are flush casement windows and are non-opening. However, for an additional cost, we can supply opening windows and tilt & turn windows in a variety of sizes, configurations and colours.

All windows are installed with a cill to allow water to run away from the building.

- All windows are supplied with 28mm clear & toughened glazing units and spacer bars
- Unique flush casement to inside and outside.
- Trickle vent for ventilation as standard
- Equal sightlines with dummy fixed casements as standard.
- Standard colour is Anthracite grey (RAL7016m) but also available in any of over 200 single or dual RAL colours.
- 'Polyamide' thermally broken profiles for energy efficiency.
- Internally glazed for extra security.

We have a highly experienced team who are many years installing doors & windows in a variety of sizes, shapes and for many different manufacturers. Through their knowledge of the market, we have selected a handful of suppliers to partner with. These partnerships have proven to be a huge success as, to-date, we have not had a single issue with any of our installations.

Final Thoughts



We recognise that a garden room is a big investment and you want to make it right, first time around and within budget.

It is not our goal or ambition to be the cheapest provider of garden rooms. We know what quality looks like, how it should perform and we do not cut corners to increase profit.

A garden room designed by Outdoor Modular Spaces is a room that will evolve over time. Your needs now will most likely change over the years. We have built garden rooms for customers who initially needed a games room for their kids, only to turn it in a bar for their now grown up kids, 2 years later.
