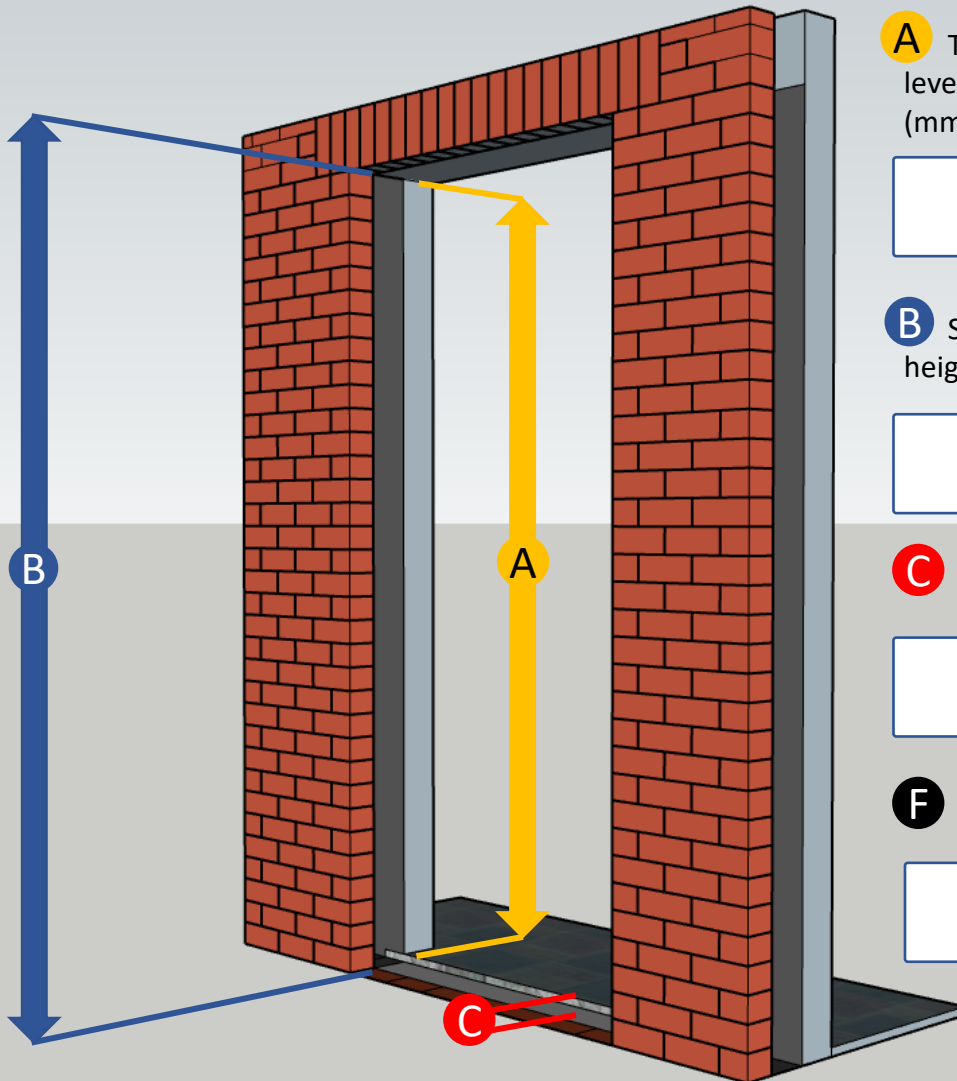

## HEIGHT MEASUREMENTS



**A** Top of internal finished floor level to underside of lintel (mm's)

**B** Structural Opening height (mm's)

**C** Required Cill Height (mm's)

**F** Frame height =  $(B) - (C) - 15\text{mm's}$

### Notes:

Check Frame Height is less than measurement **(A)**

Take at least 3 x height measurements; one on the left side, one near the centre and one on the right.

Take the smallest/tightest height measurements to ensure your finished door will fit comfortably in the opening from the 3 x separate height measurements.

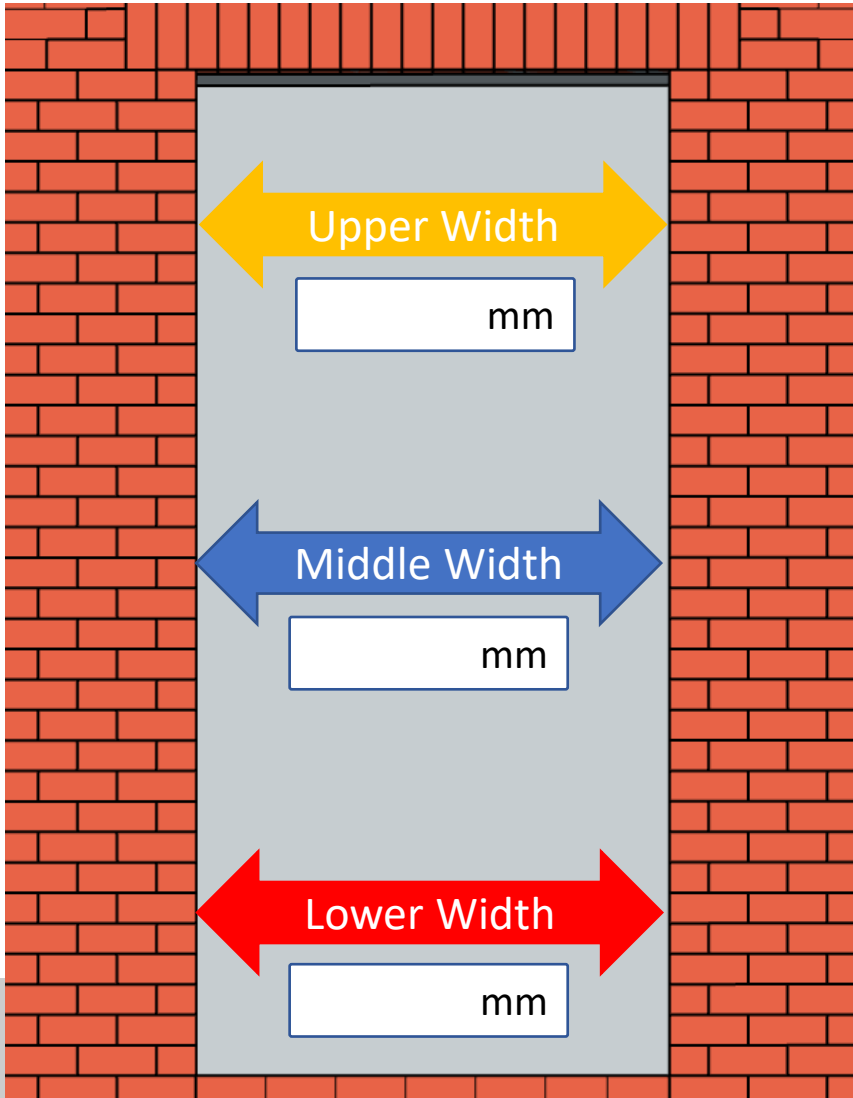
The frame height includes 15mm's tolerance to allow for a comfortable installation and ease of operation of the door.

## WIDTH MEASUREMENTS



**SMALLEST WIDTH:**  
Measured brick to brick

Minus 15mm's tolerance  
(7.5mm's either side)

**FRAME WIDTH =**

### Notes:

It is recommended to take measurements from both inside and outside the door opening to ensure your door will fit and be able to operate in the opening.

Take at least 3 x width measurements, ensuring you take the smallest / tightest size in the frame width calculation.
